ORDINANCE NO. 2007-08

**AN ORDINANCE OF DELTA BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
AMENDING THE DELTA BOROUGH WATER ORDINANCE OF JANUARY 26, 2004,
AS AMENDED, SEWER RENTAL ORDINANCE OF OCTOBER 9, 1997, AS AMENDED
AND REFUSE ORDINANCE OF MAY 27, 1986, AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2004, Delta Borough adopted the Delta Borough Water Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1997, Delta Borough adopted the Delta Borough Sewer Rental Ordinance and amended on June 28, 1999, December 18, 2000, and March 25, 2002; and

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1986, Delta Borough adopted the Delta Borough Refuse Ordinance, and amended on March 31, 1987, April 25, 1989, February 27, 1990, January 29, 1991, December 30, 1991, May 15, 1992, May 22, 1995, June 29, 1998 and June 27, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to amend the Delta Borough Water Ordinance, Sewer Rental Ordinance and Refuse Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of Delta Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, under authority of law, as follows:

SECTION 1. WATER.

a. Section 20 of the Delta Borough Water Ordinance shall be amended to delete the phrase “water committee” in its entirety from the first sentence.

b. Section 31 of the Delta Borough Water Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows:

If any of the charges due and owing on account of this Ordinance are not paid within thirty (30) days after being billed therefor, ten percent (10%) of such charges shall be added as a late charge and if the same remain due and owing sixty (60) days therefor, ten percent (10%) of all charges shall be added as a penalty for each month any sums remain delinquent. All payments made shall be applied to the oldest outstanding billings.

SECTION 2. SEWER. Section 3(A)(1) of the Delta Borough Sewer Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows:

If any of the charges due and owing on account of this Ordinance are not paid within thirty (30) days after being billed therefor, ten percent (10%) of such charges shall be added as a late charge and if the same remain due and owing sixty (60) days therefor, ten percent (10%) of all charges shall be added as a penalty for each month any sums remain delinquent. All payments made shall be applied to the oldest outstanding billings.

SECTION 3. REFUSE. Section VI(C) of the Delta Borough Refuse Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows:

If any of the charges due and owing on account of this Ordinance are not paid within thirty (30) days after being billed therefor, ten percent (10%) of such charges shall be added as a late charge and if the same remain due and owing sixty (60) days therefor, ten percent (10%) of all charges shall be added as a penalty for each month any sums remain delinquent. All payments made shall be applied to the oldest outstanding billings.

SECTION 4. REPEALER. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its enactment as provided by law.
